Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of the following conditions.

- 1. Volunteers are essential to the running of this competition. Each participating club must provide 1 jump judge per every 3 riders (or part there of ie: 5 riders = 2 jump judges) and names must be shown on the online entry. A club contact number is also required for any queries re: entries.
- 2. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- 3. All Non-Pony Club members, and any Pony Club member who cannot show their Pony Club card or prove Pony Club membership must complete the day participant waiver and liability declaration: Non-Pony Club members and PCA/PCV members who cannot prove their PCA/PCV membership must pay \$20 per day of participation unless exempt by way of holding insurance (as per Page 4 -Liability Declaration) with an equine organization or hold their

own insurance. All Non-Pony Club members, and any Pony Club member who cannot show their Pony Club card or prove Pony Club membership must provide the relevant forms to the organizing committee BEFORE riding on the day of the competition/activity on penalty of elimination https://www.ponyclubvic.org.au/wp-content/uploads/2023/01/Day-Participant-Event-Waiver-and-Liability-Declaration-2023.pdf

- 4. Before riding current PCV club member cards must be presented at the office for inspection.
- 5. PCA no smoking and alcohol policies apply.
- 6. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$15 will be deducted.
- 7. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide /combine any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- 8. Competitors may ride more than one horse (except in grade 6), subject to the conditions of PCAV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules.
- 9. Complying helmets must be worn, spot checks may occur.
- 10. Gear Check: required for all, pony club and open, riders before each phase as per the current PCA Gear Rules. The responsibility to ride in the correct competition gear remains with the competitor. If any judge or official discovers a competitor riding with incorrect competition gear, elimination may occur.

Pure Dressage, Horse Trials, Combined Training & Short Course Dressage A whip not exceeding 1200mm including the lash is permitted for Grades Adv, 1, 2 & 3. EA Tests Preliminary and above. A whip not exceeding 750mm including the flap is permitted for Grades 4, 5 & 6, EA Preparatory tests.

- 11. Medical Armbands optional but highly recommended for riders with medical conditions.
- 12. Riders under eight years of age may not compete, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- 13. Competitor numbers All riders must provide their own back numbers and holders. Competitors may supply their own numbers on bridle or saddle cloth on either side of the horse for dressage and show jumping. However, body numbers must be used for cross-country.
- 14. Body protectors are compulsory for cross country.
- 15. All competitors completing Grade 1-3 qualifying course are responsible for ensuring the qualification is correctly recorded on membership card and signed by the DC of the organising club or a zone official.
- 16. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
- 17. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws. Protests incur a \$50 fee.
- 18. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- 19. Lunging is permitted in designated area only
- 20. COVID-19 restrictions in place. Do not attend our event if you are unwell or test positive for COVID in the 5 days preceding the event.

Event Waiver and Liability Declaration Entries must be accompanied by a signed and completed Individual Member Event Waiver and Liability Declaration https://form.jotform.com/230851214048045 for each entrant. The Individual Member Event Waiver and Liability Declaration must be signed by the entrant's parent or guardian for Entrants under 18yrs of age. The parent or guardian must be over 18yrs of age. The purpose of the Individual Member Event Waiver and Liability Declaration is to limit the liability of the event organizer for any liability for personal injury or death by the Entrant. By signing the form, the Entrant is waiving their rights to sue the organizer for any losses related to personal injury or death. By signing the form, the Entrant and their parent or guardian acknowledge that horse riding is a recreational activity that is inherently dangerous and involves a significant degree of physical risk and or death. At all times the Entrant and their parent or guardian is responsible for his or her actions and participates in the activity at his or her own risk. Entries without a signed and completed Individual Member Event Waiver and Liability Declaration are unable to be accepted.
