Package Deal Entry

2 Dressage tests , Jackpot & AM7 SJ \$60 (incl. facility fee).

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions. Fees do include \$6 facility fee.

1. **Entry Fee is \$30 first dressage test, \$48 two tests. Show jumping \$20.
Package deal – 2 dressage tests and AM7 SJ \$60 incl facility fee.**
2. **PAYABLE. Cheques payable to Leighdale Pony Club Inc. / Direct deposit payment available. See Horsecomps for details.**
3. **Before riding:** PCV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office. \$10 Day Attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member* of EV/EA; AHS;HRCAV; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. *Must produce proof.
4. **Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$10 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the Day Participant Waiver below.**
5. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate within 7 days of the event less 20% administration fee. Scratchings on the day ph: **0419545360** .
6. Competitors must supply their own bridle or saddle numbers on each side of their horse. Numbers allocated on the draw.
7. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules (2019) apply and acceptance of these rules.
8. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
9. Gear check is required 30 minutes prior to both dressage and jumping. Medical armbands are optional for all competitors.
10. All riders must wear complying helmets
11. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
12. PCV Alcohol Policy Applies
13. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
14. No stallions, colts or rigs.
15. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
16. Lunging policy – lunging is not allowed at this event.
17. **Dogs and Smoking** are prohibited without exception within the Leighdale Equestrian Facility during this event. Failure to comply will result in being asked to leave.
18. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
