Draw	Dressage will commence Saturday afternoon Dressage draw will be posted on www.horsecomps.com.au prior to the event Cross country will commence at 9am Sunday morning, with A grade followed by B, C, D, and E grades. Show jumping will commence at the conclusion of cross country.

XC briefing will begin at 8:00am sharp, all judges will need to be in attendance at this time.

Conditions of Entry

- PCANSW approved helmets must be worn.
- Pony club uniform to be worn by juniors and associates. Back protectors are compulsory for cross country phase.
- Gear check before riding each phase of the competition is required.
- Any rider that falls on the day of competition, including the warm up or practice arena, must sign the indemnity waiver to continue riding in subsequent phases. If the organising committee deems continuing will compromise the safety of horse or rider, the rider will be unable to continue.
- No refunds after the closing date except with veterinarian or medical certificate.
- Entries will not be accepted without a nominated XC judge.
- Neither the organising committee of this event and volunteers accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, injury, damage or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- Riders may bring a second non competitive mount. The competitive mount must be in the higher grade and /or ridden first.
- Senior riders and pony club riders will be judged separately for awarding of placings. Winner of senior class will be rider with the lowest penalty points. In the event of a draw, closest to optimum time on XC without penalties.
- Helmet to be brought to the office for gearcheck with eventing card. Back numbers will then be distributed. ***No card, no ride. Senior riders must be graded in accordance with PCANSW grading policy and have a (PCANSW or other state pony club) eventing card.***
- The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or organising event, divide any class or alter advertised times.
- Combined training – dressage and showjumping only, Supercross – cross country and showjumping only. Riders may enter all three competitions (ODE, CT and SX) if they wish.
