Participants do not need to complete the day participant waiver (lower portion of form) or pay the \$15 day participants fee <b>IF</b> they are a current member of PCV, HRCVA EA/EV, Interstate Pony Club, AHSA, AERA, SHCA <b>BUT proof of current membership must be either emailed in advance or shown to the Secretary's Office prior to competing.</b></p>

<b>Gear Check</b>	Gear check is required before first test in Dressage Competition and after any change of gear. Elimination will occur if you have missed a gear check.
<b>Bridle, saddle numbers</b>	The Organising committee will pre-allocate and advise competitor number. Competitors must supply their own numbers. <b>Competitor numbers must be displayed on both sides of the horse.</b>

<b>Portable yards</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stabling and yards should be of solid construction. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted at Pony Club Event. Electric tape can be used as a top line or as a "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.</li> </ul>
<b>Late Entries</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If accepted will occur a late fee of \$20 per horse.</li> </ul>
<b>Scoring</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Equality of scores will be separated as per PCV Handbook of Bylaws for Dressage by law 38.2 Championship Scoring will be used.</li> </ul>
<b>Draw</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Draw will be posted on the PCAV North Eastern Zone Website <a href="http://www.northeasternzone.com">www.northeasternzone.com</a></li> <li>Draw will be emailed out to those competitors that supply their email address</li> <li>Draw will be posted on our Facebook page</li> </ul>
<b>Conditions of Entry</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgements that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.</li> <li>More than one horse may be ridden subject to the conditions of <a href="#">PCV Handbook of By-Laws</a> multiple horse rule. The organizing committee may accept none, one or more of the entries at its sole discretion.</li> <li>No refunds after the closing date except with a vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted.</li> <li>PCV membership cards must be presented to the secretaries' office before riding.</li> <li>The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel any event, alter any times or refuse any entry with or without reason. <b>The Organising Committee reserves the right to run this event over 2 days to comply with current Covid restrictions.</b></li> <li>Neither the organizing committee of this event, Numurkah Pony Club nor the PCV accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses or riders, ground spectators or any other persons or property.</li> <li>The wearing of medical armbands is now optional but highly recommended.</li> <li>Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in <a href="#">PCA Rules</a>. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination of rider.</li> <li>Uniform: All pony club members must wear pony club uniform.</li> <li>All non-pony club open riders must wear correct uniform Cream/fawn jodhpurs, fawn moleskins, white shirt, tie and coat OR HRCV Uniform.</li> <li>Queries, protests and Horse abuse rules apply as per PCV Handbook of By-Laws.</li> <li>Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.</li> <li>PCV Alcohol Policy, Sun Smart and Smoke Free Policies apply.</li> <li>Dogs are prohibited without exception.</li> <li>Lungeing is permitted in lungeing arena. Lungeing at this competition must take place in the confined arena designated exclusively for lungeing, by the organising committee. At a competition only the competitor may ride or lunge his/her horse or pony with the exception of riders under the age of 14. These riders may have another competent person over the age of 14 lunge their horse in the designated lungeing area. # Ungraded Riders Workout Activity

Part 1 <b>Enter</b>	Starting at <b>Ant</b> enter in Walk heading towards <b>Cones</b> Halt between the <b>Cones</b> and salute the judges Walk off heading towards <b>Cat</b>
Part 2 <b>Circle in Rising Trot</b>	When you get to <b>Cat</b> track left At <b>Horse</b> start rising trot Rising trot to <b>Elephant</b> At <b>Elephant</b> circle left 20 metre circle in rising trot Continue rising trot down the straight to <b>Kangaroo</b>
Part 3 <b>Change Rein</b>	Walk when you reach <b>Kangaroo</b> Continue to <b>Fox</b> At <b>Fox</b> change the rein in walk heading towards <b>Horse</b> going between <b>Cones</b> At <b>Horse</b> continue you walking around <b>Cat</b>
Part 4 <b>Rising Trot</b>	Once you reach <b>Cat</b> begin rising trot Rising trot around to <b>Fox</b> Then back to walk at <b>Fox</b>
Part 5 <b>Exit</b>	Walk on to <b>Ant</b> At <b>ANT</b> turn up the centreline heading towards <b>Cones</b> Halt between the <b>Cones</b> and salute the judges Turn right or left and leave arena in walk exiting at <b>Ant</b>
