







Craters, Caves and Coast Dressage Series Rules

GENERAL

- 1. Participation in the Series is open to all financial members of HRCAV and Associated Clubs with current Dressage gradings.
- 2. Combinations (horse and riders) may compete at their assessed Dressage Level and the next Level above as per the HRCAV Event Rule 3.2.1.
- 3. Unless otherwise specified in the Craters, Caves and Coast (CCC) Rules, the HRCAV Dressage and Event Rules will apply.
- 4. The Series is made up of 6 official HRCAV Dressage Jackpot Competitions, that consists of 2 individual tests, held across 3 weekends.
- 5. A combination must compete in a minimum of 4 individual competitions (days) to be eligible for the series placings.
- 6. CCC placing points will be awarded to a combination competing at their assessed level during the Series.
- 7. Entry into the CCC Series is included as part of the rider's entry fees in the Club competitions.
- 8. Each of the six individual club competitions comprising of the CCC Dressage Series is made up of two components:
 - a) The normal days Level placings and jackpots for which the club sashes/rosettes/ribbons will be awarded by the host club as per HRCAV rule 25.
 - b) Placings from first to last at each level will earn points towards the CCC Series competition for that combination level.
- 9. The final presentation to the winners and placegetters in the Series for each Level will be made at the conclusion of the last competition of the Series.
- 10. A combination that points up to a higher level during the dressage series can take a maximum of two of their highest placings to contribute to CCC series points from the lower level (of the CCC series), provided the combination









competes in a minimum of three (3) individual competitions (6 tests) at the higher level to go towards their overall series placing.

- 11. Riders may compete on more than one horse in the Series, with each rider/horse combination earning points as separate combinations.
- 12. Where there is a change of either rider or horse in a combination during the Series, then the new combination points tally starts afresh from that point.

SERIES PLACINGS

- 13. Placing points for the CCC Series will be awarded to a combination on the **basis of each test** 1st place = 50 points 2nd place = 49 points 3rd place = 48 points etc.
- 14. A bonus point will be awarded to each participant for every round (day) that they attend, i.e. you attend 3 events you will accumulate 3 bonus points. This will acknowledge combinations that make the effort to support the series.
- 15. The CCC Series will be determined by a combination's **best 8 Test Placings** of a possible 12 and bonus points as awarded under rule 14.
- 16. No minimum percentage is required to receive placing points for the CCC Series; however, the 60% rule will apply for the normal day's competition with respect to the allocation of HRCAV points.
- 17. In the event of equal Series Placings occurring the following process will occur to eliminate any equal placings:
 - a) The rider that has the higher number of points earned at the current level is placed higher;
 - b) The rider that has the highest number of first places, second etc. is placed higher;
 - c) The rider that has the competed in the most events will be placed higher.
 - d) A summation of percentages will be used to break any ties.
