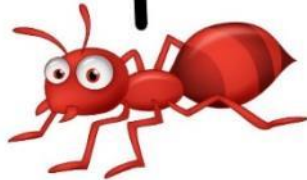
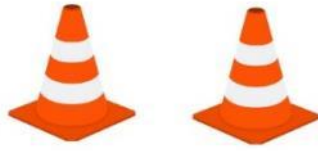
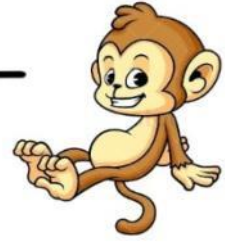

Ungraded Riders Workout Activity

Part 1 Enter	Starting at Ant enter in Walk heading towards Cones Halt between the Cones and salute the judges Walk off heading towards Cat
Part 2 Circle in Rising Trot	When you get to Cat track left At Horse start rising trot Rising trot to Elephant At Elephant circle left 20 metre circle in rising trot Continue rising trot down the straight to Kangaroo
Part 3 Change Rein	Walk when you reach Kangaroo Continue to Fox At Fox change the rein in walk heading towards Horse going between Cones At Horse continue you walking around Cat
Part 4 Rising Trot	Once you reach Cat begin rising trot Rising trot around to Fox Then back to walk at Fox
Part 5 Exit	Walk on to Ant At ANT turn up the centreline heading towards Cones Halt between the Cones and salute the judges Turn right or left and leave arena in walk exiting at Ant

Portable yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stabling and yards should be of solid construction. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted at Pony Club Event. Electric tape can be used as a top line or as a "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.
Late Entries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If accepted will occur a late fee of \$20 per horse.
Scoring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equality of scores will be separated as per PCV handbook of bylaws for Combined Training by law 38.5
Draw	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw will be posted on the PCAV North Eastern Zone Website www.northeasternzone.com • Draw will be emailed out to those competitors that supply their email address • Draw will be posted on our Facebook page

<p>Conditions of Entry</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgements that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules. 2. More than one horse may be ridden subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of By-Laws multiple horse rule. The organizing committee may accept none, one or more of the entries at its sole discretion. 3. No refunds after the closing date except with a vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted. 4. PCV membership cards will be inspected on the day of the event, all riders are to have two (2) rallies within the preceding 12 months. HRCAV & EA will be prevalidated by Event Secretary. 5. The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel any event, alter any times or refuse any entry with or without reason. 6. Neither the organizing committee of this event, Numurkah Pony Club nor the PCV accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses or riders, ground spectators or any other persons or property. 7. The wearing of medical armbands is now optional but highly recommended. 8. Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCA Rules. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination of rider. 9. Uniform: All pony club members must wear pony club uniform. 10. All non-pony club open riders must wear correct uniform Cream/fawn jodhpurs, fawn moleskins, white shirt, tie and coat OR HRCAV Uniform. 11. Queries, protests and Horse abuse rules apply as per PCV Handbook of By-Laws. 12. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs. 13. PCV Alcohol Policy, Sun Smart and Smoke Free Policies apply. 14. Dogs are prohibited without exception. 15. Lunging is permitted in lunging arena. Lunging at this competition must take place in the confined arena designated exclusively for lunging, by the organising committee. Only the competitor may ride or lunge their horse or pony with the exception of riders under the age of 14 years. These riders may have another competent person over the age of 14 lunge their horse in the designated lunging area. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination. 16.
