General Conditions of Entry:

- Open to members of riding clubs affiliated with HRCav and conducted under HRCav rules and regulations.
- Cardless Event as per HRCav Guidelines
- Competitors provide their own bridle or saddle blanket numbers to be displayed on both sides of the horse.
- Club uniform and approved helmet to be worn. Neat club attire to be worn for presentation photos.
- Riders must present to Gear Check 20 mins prior to Phase 1. Dressage & again for Phase 2. Obstacles -Style as per Event rule 13.2.
- Dogs are to be on a lead at all times. No dogs allowed in the administration & competition areas.
- Protests must be submitted in writing to the Event Secretary.
- The decision of the ground jury is final and no secondary protests will be entered into.
- RREC accepts no responsibility for any accident, damage, injury, illness or loss to any person, horse or property.
- The Organisers reserve the right to divide any section or alter the advertised day/times.
- NO refunds after closing date unless Vet or Medical certificate is supplied within 14 days of competition. 25% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund.
- If, for any reason this event is canceled, an administration charge of \$10 per rider will be retained by the OC to help cover expenses incurred.
