Ribbons: PCV Combined Training 1st to 6th, Open Combined Training 1st to 4th. Ribbons for all competitors: Ungraded Workout and Handy Mount Activity.

Failure to do so WILL result in elimination. <p>OPEN RIDERS PLEASE NOTE: ALL participants in an Open competition, must sign a Public Liability Declaration Form, Participants do not need to complete the day participant waiver (lower portion of form) or pay the \$20 day participants fee IF they are a current member of PCV, HRCV, EA/EV, Interstate Pony Club, AHSA, AERA, SHCA Proof of current membership to one of these organisations and the day participant waiver form must be completed prior to competing. | Gear Check:- | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gear check is required before each phase and after any change of gear. Elimination will occur if you have missed a gear check. PCV dressage whip rules apply as per PCA exception. <p><u>Pure Dressage, Horse Trials, Combined Training & Short Course Dressage</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A whip not exceeding 1200mm including the lash is permitted for Grades Adv, 1, 2 & 3. EA Tests Preliminary and above. A whip not exceeding 750mm including the flap is permitted for Grades 4, 5 & 6, EA Preparatory tests. |
| Bridle / Saddle Numbers: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Organising Committee will pre-allocate and advise competitor numbers. Competitors must supply their own numbers. |
| Portable Yards | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Yards should be of solid construction. The use of electric tape, string, ropes or chains is not permitted at Pony Club Events. Electric tape can be used as a top line or as a "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard. |
| Late Entries | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If accepted will occur a late fee of \$20 per horse. |
| Scoring | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Equality of scores will be separated as per PCV handbook of bylaws for Combined Training by law 38.5 Equaliser points:- 5 points for every dressage level above CT assessed level will be implemented in PC classes. |
| Draw | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Draw will be emailed out to those competitors that supply their email address Draw will be posted on our Facebook page |

Conditions of Entry

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgements that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
2. More than one horse may be ridden subject to the conditions [PCV Handbook of By-laws](#) multiple horse rule. The organizing committee may accept none, one or more of the entries at its sole discretion.
3. No refunds after the closing date except with a vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted.
4. PCV membership cards must be presented with entry.
5. The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel any event, alter any times or refuse any entry with or without reason.
6. Neither the organising committee of this event, Rochester Pony Club nor the PCV accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses or riders, ground spectators or any other persons or property.
7. The wearing of medical armbands is now optional but highly recommended.
8. Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in [PCA rules](#). Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination of rider.
9. Uniform: All pony club members must wear pony club uniform.
10. All non-pony club open riders must wear correct uniform Cream/fawn/white jodhpurs, fawn moleskins, white shirt, tie and coat OR HRCAV Uniform.
11. Queries, protests and horse abuse rules apply as per PCV Handbook or By-Laws.
12. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
13. PCV Alcohol Policy, Sun Smart and Smoke Free Policies apply.
14. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
15. Lunging is permitted in lunging arena. Lunging at this competition must take place in the confined arena designated exclusively for lunging, by the organising committee. At a competition only the competitor may ride or lunge his/her horse or pony. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.
