Advanced and Level 1 may be combined. Separate classes will be held for Ridden/Rider/ Best educated.

All classes receive TTT points except for Champion & Reserve.

HIGH POINT AWARDS FOR EACH LEVEL as per TTT points. If a countback is required, the best performance in Ridden Mount class then SOP/ MMS/Rider/Led classes will be used to determine the winner.

\*Denotes classes eligible for points on performance cards.

^ Mount Suitable for HRC AV class may include a jump.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: \*NO CARD EVENT (financial status and level will be confirmed via HRC AV database). \*Teams must provide 1 x volunteer helper. \*Competitors may ride one horse only. \*Requests for refunds after closing date must be received in writing and be supported by a valid doctor or vet certificate. Refund requests will be received up to 14 days after day of event. \*An admin charge of \$10 will be retained on scratchings after close of entries & prior to the draw being released. \*After draw has been released the admin charge will be \$22.50. \*Swabbing may occur. \*Protests must be lodged in writing at the Secretary's office within 30 minutes of posting of results and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee. \*Disputes regarding team placings must be accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$50. \*The Ground Jury's decision is final. No secondary protest can be entered. \*Prizes must be collected. \*Whittlesea Adult Riders and the Whittlesea Agricultural Society do not accept liability for accidents, damage, illness or injury or loss to any person, horse or property. No dogs allowed.
